

Coltsfoot

Composite Family
(Tussilago farfara)



Coltsfoot has a dandelion-like flower about one inch wide. The plant itself can be up to 18 inches tall. It appears in early spring before the leaves, which are toothed and heart-shaped. The stalk is scaly. It prefers the damp soil of banks, stream sides and roadsides. The seed head is very fluffy, similar to that of a dandelion.
