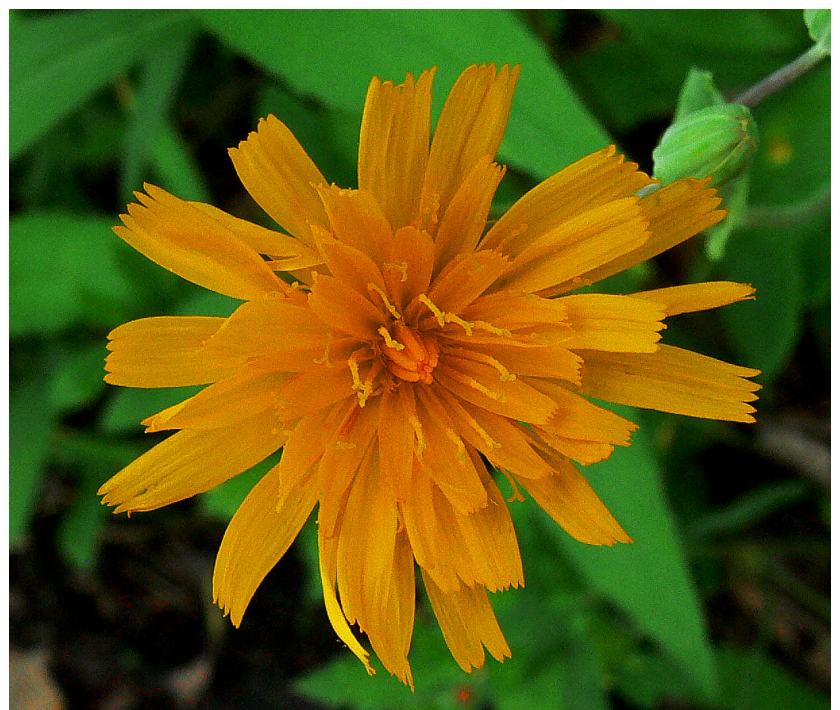


# Two-flowered Cynthia

**Composite Family**  
***(Krigia biflora)***



Two-flowered Cynthia has a fork near the middle of the stem. There is a clasping leaf in that fork. It has a deep orange-yellow flower that is 1-1½ inches wide. It grows 1-2 feet high in open woods and meadows. It blooms in late spring and summer.



Native species.
